Caring for the Poor

During Pope Francis' visit to the US, he reached out to Christians with his message of caring for the poor. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) has been putting these words into practice for 170 years. Your financial contributions each month support the following activities:

- Feeding the hungry with a sack lunch 5 days a week at St. Lawrence Haven.
- Providing food assistance for the poor at the St. James Pantry and a shelter for victims of domestic abuse.
- Furnishing free clothing for the neediest of people at the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center.
- Giving financial assistance to individuals with unpaid rent and utilities.

In the parish vestibule each week, we collect food for the St. James Pantry. This month, we are asking for donations of canned soup since the pantry is currently unable to order this item from their suppliers.

Throughout the Bible, God's people are reminded to care for those in need. Everyone needs food, clothing, and shelter. Even if we don't have much, we should use what we do have to help others. Whether it is providing a sandwich at St. Lawrence Haven or a warm winter coat at the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center, small things can make a difference.

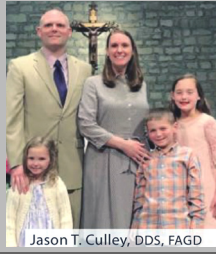
