Tuesday Morning Bible Study is looking at the book of *Hebrews: The New and Eternal Covenant*, presented by Andrew Swafford and Jeff Cavins. According to the publisher, Ascension Press, "The book of Hebrews is like a little Catechism. It is steeped in rich truths that are foundational to our Catholic Faith, but its highly refined theological concepts can be difficult for even the most seasoned Bible scholars to unpack... (This study) draws out the riches of this sublime book in a way that makes them easier to understand. It draws connections between the Old and New Testaments, the Liturgy, the Eucharist, the priesthood, and so much more. Most importantly, Hebrews will help Catholics appreciate the astounding generosity of God as they see the wonders He has given us in the Church." This will be an eight-session study. We meet Tuesday mornings in the Teachers' Lounge after the 9:00 a.m. Mass. It is highly recommended that participants purchase the accompanying workbook; cost of the workbook is \$30.00. Helping Families with Food Insecurity

Food prices are soaring, and families are having a difficult time keeping up. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, food prices rose by 11% over the prior 12 months, the largest increase since 1978. This rapid increase in grocery prices is driving many food-insecure families to turn to charities.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is helping address this problem of low food security with the St. Lawrence Haven operation, located at 244 E. Rich Street in downtown Columbus. Volunteers from parishes throughout the diocese make sandwiches and hot meals which feed 450 people each day. Food is prepared and packed Monday through Thursday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and distributed from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. at Holy Cross Church. Members of St. Timothy Church make sandwiches for St. Lawrence Haven on the second Sunday of each month after the 9:00 a.m. Mass.

St. Lawrence Haven is currently in desperate need of food supplies. The following items are in short supply:

- Granola Bars
- Individual chips
- Individual apple sauce, pudding, fruit cups
- Individually wrapped cookies or crackers

As you come to Mass, please deliver them to the grocery cart in the church lobby. Thank you for all your support.

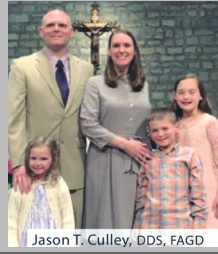
