### WHAT IS THE ADVENT WREATH?

Advent wreaths are traditionally made of evergreen branches, which have long been a symbol of the constancy and faithfulness we aspire to as Christians. Each of the four candles on an Advent wreath has specific meaning. The first

Sunday of Advent symbolizes HOPE. The second Sunday symbolizes FAITH, and the third Sunday symbolizes JOY. The Fourth and final Sunday of Advent symbolizes PEACE. The Advent wreath is a beautiful way to enter into reflection about the Christmas Season. It can be a source of peace, grace and blessings shared with everyone, and Christians throughout time.

**AROUND THE TOWN AND BEYOND****LATEST NEWS FROM SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY****Helping a Neighbor Facing Eviction**

Since August of 2020, our St. Timothy Conference has partnered with other Society of St. Vincent de Paul organizations (SVDP) and has assisted 215 families with their past due rent and utilities through our home visit program. Most of these families were facing eviction after struggling to make their monthly rent and utility bills. One recent example was Sam, a mother with three children that lives in our St. Timothy neighborhood. Sam worked in a restaurant the last five years until medical emergencies required her to quit her job. Currently, the family's sole source of support was a disability check from her husband suffering from multiple sclerosis. SVDP provided rent assistance to stop eviction proceedings and supplied the family with other resources to apply for additional assistance. Sam was very grateful for our financial help which allowed them to remain in their home. God's own goodness touches the world through our charitable acts. Thanks to all our SVDP contributors for making a real difference in the lives of the poor.

The **IRA Charitable Rollover** allows donors who are 70.5 years or older to transfer up to \$100,000.00 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. In doing so, donors keep their IRA distribution from impacting their gross income and possibly avoid being bumped into a higher tax bracket. The IRA charitable rollover can also count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD), which starts at age 72.

All transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation by December 15th to qualify as a 2022 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income. 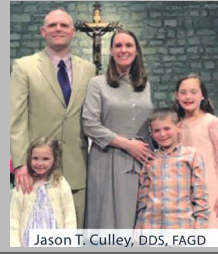
