We are in the midst of new beginnings here at St. Timothy. School is off to a roaring start and with COVID restrictions at a lower level, many want to resume former practices and activities. All is good and fine except many who volunteered three years ago may have lost their enthusiasm to be involved. Our **parish survival** is dependent on family participation, particularly in connecting our school families with our Sunday celebration of the Eucharist. Since my arrival here at St. Timothy two years ago, I have had 36 Baptisms as compared to 47 funerals. The most frightening statistic, however, is that there have only been **two** weddings. Most couples are getting married in barns, ? and not establishing a family grounded in our Catholic faith. This is why it is important to strongly encourage your children and grandchildren to practice their faith every weekend. It will only help them in the long run. It helps to their survival as a couple/family and ours as well as church.

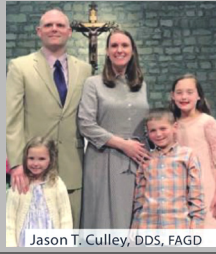
