PASTOR'S DESK

From the Desk of Father Dan



This weekend is the kickoff for the Annual Diocesan Appeal. This year's goal is 7.5 million dollars. There are several areas that are slated to receive one to two million from the campaign: evangelization, Catholic education and tuition assistance, vocations, and social concerns. I ask that you seriously consider your gift to the Appeal because the Church is bigger than our parish, and these are legitimate needs that need support for the various ministries of the Diocese. There are envelopes in the pews. Please be generous. In the next week or two, you may return your envelope in the offertory basket, by mail to the rectory office, or by dropping it off in the rectory.

Our parish goal is \$94,074. As in the past, if a parish donates more than its goal, that money is returned to the parish. A change this year is that for those parishes who do not meet their goal, they will be assessed the difference between the parish's contribution and the parish goal in the following year's diocesan tax assessment.

PAUSE FOR THOUGHT

Jesus' Love for Us

"No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." – John 15:13

We can always discover a deeper meaning of a Scripture text when we read it within its context. These words of Jesus about loving one's friends were spoken at the Last Supper. That was the momentous night before he would lay down his life for his friends to be nailed to the Cross. These words about laying down one's life were extremely personal to Jesus at that precise time. The statement gives a clear insight into his mind the day before his crucifixion. Jesus explains that there is no one who has more love for one's friends than one offering one's supreme self-sacrifice.

In this same chapter of John, Jesus explicitly says that we – all of us – are the friends he has chosen and loves beyond description. We need to bow our heads with profound humility, realizing Jesus' intense love for us exceeds even his intense pain on the Cross.

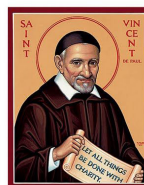

Mercy Bags for the Homeless

"Blessed is the one who considers the poor. In the day of trouble, the Lord delivers him."

Psalm 41:1

Homelessness has developed into an epidemic in many parts of the United States. The problem is distinguishing between the homeless who really need help and the con artists who prey on human kindness and compassion. Some people are pretending to be homeless as they promote their drug addiction. The Christian way is to respond to the need. A speaker at the Women's Prayer Breakfast a few years ago who was herself homeless said it is not a good idea to give money to the panhandler. Instead, she suggested providing attention such as a smile and a reassuring word.

One way that you can help homeless people find shelters and other resources is carrying around contact "street cards" for homeless service agencies in Columbus. These cards can help homeless people access information to find shelters, free meals and clothing, healthcare, mental health, and substance abuse services. The street cards can be found in the vestibule or printed out at <https://columbushomeless.org/>.

The Society of St Vincent de Paul (SVDP) will be making "Mercy Bags" for the homeless in the Teachers' Lounge on Wednesday, May 15 at 4:00 p.m. The Mercy Bags will be stuffed with food items such as Slim Jims, tuna meals, granola bars and bottled water. Each Mercy Bag will have the street card described above listing the additional resources for the homeless. SVDP members will pass out the Mercy Bags to interested parishioners after the Masses on May 18 and 19 to keep in your car to give to those who approach you at street corners.
